<p>The charge for plan review and inspection of new or remodel construction is based on the estimated amount of time required for plan reviews and two inspections.</p> <p>Refunds - fees will be refunded for withdrawn construction plans minus the actual costs incurred up until and including the date of withdrawal.</p> <p>The use of the following abbreviations in this document are defined as:</p> <p>CBC - California Building Code  NFPA - National Fire Protection Association  NFPA 13D - Standard for 1 and 2 family residential sprinkler systems and manufactured homes  NFPA 13R - Standard for residential sprinkler systems under four stories  NFPA 13 - Standard for installation of sprinkler systems  UFC - Uniform Fire Code</p>
