CAL FIRE Prescribed Burn Tuesday and Wednesday at UC Santa Cruz

Felton –On Tuesday February 13th firefighters from CAL FIRE and local fire agencies are planning to conduct a prescribed burn at UC Santa Cruz upper campus and the Natural Reserve. Burning may also occur on Wednesday if conditions remain favorable.

The prescribed burn is a cooperative project with UC Santa Cruz and CAL FIRE for reducing the threat of wildfire and enhancing natural resources. There will be a temporary road closure along Chinquapin Road during the burning operations. Smoke will be visible from many areas in Santa Cruz County and is no cause for alarm.

Four CAL FIRE engines, one City of Santa Cruz Fire Department engine, one water tender from Boulder Creek Fire District and two Ben Lomond Fire Crews will be present for the burning operation.
