
Change in Santa Cruz County Volunteer Firefighters' Representative to the County Fire Department Advisory Commission (FDAC)

Dear Members of the Board:

The ordinance establishing the Fire Department Advisory Commission (FDAC) includes the requirement of a representative from the Santa Cruz County Volunteer Firefighters as part of the structure of the commission. That representative has been Luisa Haddad, from Company 37 – Davenport since May of 2011, and she has performed her duties with admirable dedication and commitment. Her personal expertise, cooperative spirit and sound judgment have made her a valuable asset to the FDAC as well as to County Fire as a whole.

At the FDAC and Company Officers' meetings held on May 23, 2012, Ms. Haddad announced her resignation from this position.
